Attendance

The rate of attendance* for the school in 2019 was:

Management of Non-Attendance

If a student is absent the staff of the College contact the student's parents/guardians immediately by phone or text. If no response is received the staff of the College contact any agencies with which the student is registered or engaged. If a student is absent without reasonable explanation for a period of more than three days, or if a member of staff judges that attendance is an issue, the College's team of re-engagement officers will contact the student and/or the student's parent/guardian and if necessary initiate a re-engagement plan. Regular non-attendance will result in counselling and the development of a re-engagement plan. If all attempts to locate a student fail and no advice has been received that the student has enrolled at another school, the College will contact the Education Regional Office.

Professional Development

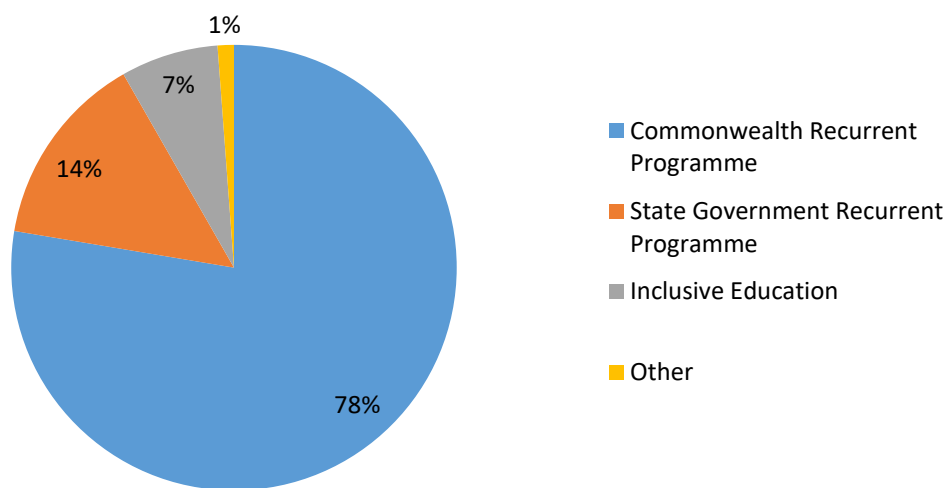

Family Survey

A survey was sent to all families seeking information on levels of involvement in the school. There were 30 responses from approximately 440 surveys sent.
